STAVELEY PLAYGROUND

Staveley Village Association and its supporters have raised £100k (of the £120k required) to renovate the Staveley Playground. This includes grants from Cumbria County Council and The National Lottery.

Installation of the new equipment is scheduled to begin in early April and should be complete before 1st May.

We need to raise £15k through donations and community events.

ALEX ROW

The Parish Council is working with SLDC to redesign and improve the appearance of the recycling area. This is a work in progress but expect to see some changes this summer.



SEWAGE REPORT

The Parish Council has now established a Task Group to try to resolve the unsatisfactory sewage discharges. The problem is caused by the pipe under the Kent being too small as it takes waste from the village to the WWTW. A moratorium on new build that threatens to increase sewage overspills is now in place. Monitors will be installed in the sewerage system soon.

HIGHWAYS CONSULTATION

We are awaiting a consultation on highways improvements from Cumbria County Council this spring in Staveley and Ings. Proposals include parking restrictions and 20mph limits. Look out for the consultation on noticeboards and social media.
